About Amber Cottage

UPA Orange is pleased to make Amber Cottage available to “out-of-town” relatives and / or friends of residents residing in UPA Central West’s Residential Aged Care Services.

Amber Cottage is a two-bedroom self contained unit that will accommodate up to 3 people.

The unit is available for short term stays to ensure that as many visitors as possible have access to the accommodation.

Should special circumstances arise, management would be able to negotiate the possibility of a longer stay e.g. illness or unexpected hospitalisation of a resident.

The Unit contains:

- One double bed
- One single bed
- Linen (towels, sheets, blankets)
- Pillows
- Clock/Radio
- TV
- Crockery, cutlery, kitchen utensils
- Cooking amenities
- Refrigerator
- Electric heating
- Portable air conditioner
- Washing Machine and Dryer
- Ironing board & electric iron
