The other great advantage of living in a Retirement Village is the ability to lock up and go away without worrying about the security of your home.


Our Villages operate under Government legislation:

All units and villas have an emergency call system installed for your safety and peace of mind.

Each village has a common room for meetings and activities.

The Hunter Region's Village Manager and coordinators visit the villages regularly. They are able to assist with the organising of outings and activities. They are also able to help you access government funded services/or private services to help you remain independent at home.

Fee Structure

The fortnightly fee for a single occupant is 25% of the single aged pension and for a couple it is 20% of the couples' pension rate.

The fees cover:


- ✓ General insurance for the buildings

Residents are responsible for their own electricity, phone and internet costs, and contents insurance.


Residents buy the units as a non-registered interest holder.

Woodlands Village | Wallsend (54 Units/Villas)

The Village is built on a 5-hectare property. It is quiet and private. There is a heated swimming pool for the residents and their families to use.

Woodlands Place

Located on the south and west perimeter of the property. There are 30 single story two-bedroom villas, surrounded by lawn and gardens.

Woodlands Grove

Located on the South boundary of the property, all 23 units have north facing living rooms with internal access to the attached garages.




Sarina Court | Maryland (12 Villas)


Ellimatta Village | East Maitland (17 Units)


